

PM&DC Finalizes Preparations for Nationwide Digital Inspector Training

Islamabad 2nd December 2025: The Pakistan Medical & Dental Council (PM&DC) convened an important meeting at its headquarters to finalize arrangements for the upcoming three-day National Inspector Training Program scheduled to be held on 9th to 11th december 2025. The program will train inspectors in conducting fully digitalized inspections as part of PM&DC's modernization initiative. The meeting brought together 12 Master Trainers to review the training framework, logistics, and implementation strategy for the nationwide pilot training aimed at digitalizing the PM&DC inspection system.

The meeting was chaired by the President of PM&DC, During the meeting, participants discussed the structured three-day training program designed to enhance the competency and readiness of master inspectors responsible for training inspectors who will evaluate medical and dental colleges across the country. Key agenda items included finalization of the digital inspection workflow, allocation of facilitators, selection of participating institutions, and preparation of training materials such as the Inspector Guide and the digital platform.

It was emphasized that the upcoming training will equip inspectors with updated knowledge, digital tools, and standardized methodologies essential for conducting credible, efficient, and evidence-based inspections.
